The seemingly Haphazard Imagery I painted in 2020 reflects a year of fear, uncertainty, and loss;


The Theme of 2020 was Themelessness; Now it's time to Move On.






BRIDGE BASE 36 x 48" acrylic on canvas 2020






INTERIOR WITH PAINTED WALL 20 x 24" acrylic on canvas 2020


