Every human action is accompanied by a state of mind.


Before you take any action, your mind decides which direction it will take you.



JCAT began with an exhibition for just one artist, and since then, has supported over 2,000 artists.

Started an exhibition for one artist in an apartment in Brooklyn, New York, which was once a shoe factory, and it was a huge success. After that, through Ouchi Gallery, Japanese artists were able to connect with people all over the world.

It became a gallery where bookings could not be made for two years in advance. After that, JCAT NY was founded, allowing it to work all over the world without a physical location.

JCAT Exhibition group and solo exhibitions were held online. The JCAT Online Gallery was updated every month and could be accessed 24 hours a day, connecting the art world with the online world.

A physical exhibition were held in Chelsea, New York in July, and in Paris, France in December.
We have started matching JCAT artists with art lovers.

Noho M55 Gallery is a partnership of two of the oldest and most respected artist-led galleries in New York. Our guiding philosophy is to exhibit artworks of high quality in all media, diverse in style and content. Member artists are allowed the freedom to control their own destinies while benefiting from professional guidance from our combined 85-years experience. M55 Art (originally 55 Mercer Street Artists) was formed in 1969 at 55 Mercer Street and Noho Gallery (originally located just north of Houston Street) formed in 1975. In 2012 the two became partners.
